<u>Questions</u>

Putting Sin to Death Means You Can Fight It (Colossians 3:5-7; Romans 7:15, 22-25, 8:13; Matthew 18:8)

- Where does the battle against sin begin? How does sin deceive us?
- Why should we kill sin? What has God given us to fight against sin?
- How do you fight sin in your own life? What does this battle look like every day?

Admitting There Is Sin to Fight Is a Challenge and a Comfort (Colossians 3:8-10; Hebrews 12:5-6; Romans 8:23)

- Why does God discipline His children? Why is this necessary?
- Why do we "groan inwardly"? What should this remind us of?
- What does "the new self" in Colossians 3:10 have to do with our fight against sin? How does this both challenge you and comfort you?

All Christians Can Have an Equal Share of Christ (Colossians 3:10-11; Ephesians 2:14-16)

- What is the ultimate point of Colossians 3:11?
- How does Ephesians 2:14-16 help us see that putting on "the new self" is not about anything we have done?
- How does knowing "Christ is all, and in all" help you as you fight against sin and live for Christ?

5 Application Points

Consider your sin dead through faith in Jesus Fight to continuously identify and kill sin Admit your sin specifically Stop feeling sorry for yourself Start trusting that Christ is enough
