Questions

God's Designs Are Never Arbitrary (Colossians 3:18-20; Ephesians 5:22-24; Genesis 3:16; 1 Corinthians 11:3)

- How does God's design for marriage and family have an influence on society?
- What are the roles that God has called men and women to within marriage? How is this challenging? How is it encouraging?
- What do the roles in marriage teach us about God and His creation?

Christian Men Must Lead with Intention (Colossians 3:19, 21, 23-24; Ephesians 5:25-26; 6:4; Proverbs 1:8)

- How are husbands called to lead their families?
- How do husbands apply Ephesians 5:25-26?
- If you are a father, what are some ways that you are bringing up your children in the discipline and instruction of the Lord? What do fathers need in order to do this well?

Submitting to God's Design Builds a Better Culture (Colossians 3:22-4:1; Galatians 4:7; Ephesians 6:9)

- What is the eternally minded takeaway from Colossians 3:22-4:1?
- How does "working heartily as for the Lord" help you as you perform daily work?
- How does God's design for the family and the workplace stand in contrast to the way the world does things? Which one does your family look more like?

Repent of any action or attitude that defies God's design for family Wives submit to your husbands as to the Lord Husbands lead your families as Christ leads Engage the culture with the design of God in all spheres
